DISCUSSION & PRAYER (PHILIPPIANS 4:6-7)

DISCOVERY TEXT -

Psalm 133

(Read this passage on your own and aloud as a group.)

- 1. What stands out to you from this passage? (If your group agrees to see some context, <u>Leviticus 8:12</u> is where Moses anoints his brother Aaron for the priesthood.)
- 2. Think about your family and your neighborhood. What gets in the way of people making meaningful friendships?

APPLICATION

1. Read <u>1 Corinthians 1:10</u>. Why is it important for you to live in harmony with other disciples of Jesus?

2. When you think of loneliness as a widespread epidemic, does anyone come to mind? What would you be willing to do to help alleviate someone's loneliness?

3. How have you seen God working during this time of Prayer and Fasting?
