What Breakthrough Are You Seeking?

"God, you are my God; I earnestly search for you. My soul thirsts for you; my whole body longs for you in this parched and weary land where there is no water."

-Psalm 63:1 (NLT)

Fasting and prayer are practices that Jesus modeled and that His disciples have continued for over 2,000 years. What spiritual breakthroughs will you focus on during your 21-day experience?

Heart. Are you feeling spiritually dried up? Is there a sinful pattern you need to break? An attitude that needs to change? A grudge you need to release? A confession you need to make? What fear keeps you from living out loud for Jesus? What barriers keep you from taking your next big step of faith?

Household. Who in your family has not yet put their faith in Jesus? What relationships are strained or broken? Is someone battling an illness or an addiction?

Neighborhood. How aware are you of your neighbor's goals and challenges? Do you live in a close-knit community, or are people more isolated from each other? What would it take for you and your neighbors to gather together and praise God?

Nations. New Day has "adopted" the Samburu and Rendille people in Northern Kenya, so you will see prayer prompts about them. God may be putting other nations (or "people groups") on your heart too, including people groups who live within our own national boundaries.

Fasting helps us focus. It is the act of intentionally letting go of something that gives you comfort (certain foods, social media, news/entertainment...), and then letting your discomfort remind you to go to God in prayer, to call out to Him for breakthroughs, and to open yourself to His will.

I pray that God would use this fasting and prayer initiative to break through spiritual barriers in hearts, households, neighborhoods and nations. May we receive Him like a parched and weary land receives the rain. Amen!

Worldwide Breakthrough: An Explanation of New Day's Partnership with Lifeway Global



Who is Lifeway Global?

Lifeway Global (lifewayglobal.org) is a Kenya-based missions organization that has catalyzed one of the most explosive movements of God in our lifetime. Over the past two decades, millions of people in East Africa with backgrounds in Islam, shamanism and witchcraft have become disciples of Jesus. Out of obedience to Jesus, those disciples are reaching the next unreached people groups.

How did Our Partnership Begin?

In 2021, New Day was invited by Lifeway Global to participate in a vision trip to Northern Kenya. We visited people from the Samburu and Rendille people groups. Dr. Aila Tasse, founder of Lifeway Global, referred to them as "gateway tribes," meaning that God has positioned them to bring the Gospel to other unreached people groups. After the vision trip, we accepted Lifeway's invitation to continue connecting with the Samburu and Rendille people.

What is the Goal?

Our primary goal is to make more disciples, across the street and around the world. We'll do that by encouraging and supporting disciples among the Samburu and Rendille tribes as they make more disciples. As we do that, New Day is learning about Disciple-Multiplying Movements (DMM). Lifeway Global has catalyzed DMMs among dozens of people groups. Along with hundreds of other churches across North America, New Day is taking a closer look at Scripture and at multiplying movements in order to learn and practice the habits of multiplying disciples. We're praying for DMMs to continue in East Africa, and to spread to North America.

This Year's Breakthrough

Sabaya, the leader of the Samburu/Rendille Disciple-Multiplying team, said in a recent Zoom call that they are facing a language barrier. While the Samburu and Rendille tribes often live side by side, they come from different backgrounds and speak distinct languages. Lifeway has a plan to help. They record people reading Scripture in local dialects, and then equip disciple-makers with audio bibles. One audio bible can help an entire village hear and obey God's Word together. In our recent Christmas offering, New Day raised enough money to provide fifty audio bibles to help Sabaya's team break through the language barrier. Praise the Lord!

WEEK 1: YOUR HEART-A BREAKTHROUGH IN FAITH

JANUARY 26, 2025

DAY

Scripture: Isaiah 43:19 (NASB 2020) "Behold, I am going to do something new, Now it will spring up; Will you not be aware of it? I will even make a roadway in the wilderness, Rivers in the desert."

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to open your eyes to the new things He is doing in your heart, your household, your neighborhood, and the nations. Ask Him to give you faith to trust His plan.

A "New Thing" Among The Nations: "The arid northern parts of Kenya are home to tribes like the Gabra, Rendille, Borana, Burji, and Daasanach, all classified (currently, or up until recently) as Unreached People Groups (UPGs)... I knew that bringing these people groups into God's kingdom was the 'new thing' God was going to perform." –Dr. Aila Tasse, Cabbages in the Desert (p23)



This "new thing" (Isaiah 43:19) became a movement of multiplying disciples called Lifeway Global. In the first three months of 2024, God added 1,556 new Discovery Bible Studies, 891 new churches, and 1,422 leaders trained in East Africa alone. What will it take for the number of Christ-followers to grow in North America, where Christianity has been in decline for decades?



On Monday, January 15, 2024, Sabaya brought his younger sister to school in rural Northern Kenya. Her tuition was due, and the cost was twice as much as Sabaya had. On that same day, on the other side of the world, Sabaya was featured in New Day's 21 Days of Prayer guide. We prayed specifically for Sabaya, including a petition to God that He would meet Sabaya's every need. Back in Kenya, when Sabaya presented half the money required for his sister's tuition, the school told him, "This is fine; you are paid in full." How is God meeting your every need today (Matthew 6:33, 2 Corinthians 9:6-8)?

The Race to Help the Rendille Hear the Good News

Somali Muslims have made a push to convert Rendille villages in Northern Kenya. When that happens, one of the first rules set by the village's new religion is that they cannot allow Christians to come around. On the other hand, Rendille people who hear and embrace the Good News of Jesus learn to follow His commands to love and to be a light to the world. Sabaya (who is Samburu, not Rendille) tells us the language barrier is their biggest challenge right now. New Day's special Christmas offering raised enough money to purchase 50 audio bibles that will make it possible for Sabaya and his team to bring Scripture to Rendille people in their own language. Pray for God to raise more Rendille-speaking leaders in Northern Kenya.

Special Feature: Meet the Samburu/Rendille (S/R) Team

Over the last three years, New Day has watched a movement develop among the Samburu and Rendille (S/R) villages in Northern Kenya. Villages that had only recently heard the name of Jesus in our first year are now sending people to leadership training.

Every level of Lifeway Global's Disciple-Multiplying Movements (DMM) includes the same five key leadership responsibilities. The S/R team is no exception. Please pray for these indigenous leaders as they help their own people groups grow in Christ, and equip them to reach the unreached people groups around them.

New Day's financial contributions have helped provide life-saving drought relief (which opened doors for conversations about Jesus), a physical training center centrally located for the S/R people, and audio bibles. Our visits and prayers have encouraged leaders and generated momentum. When we go to remote villages in Kenya, people gather to find out why American people came from the cold to visit them in the desert. They find out that it's because Jesus invites us all to be brothers and sisters together with one Heavenly Father!


